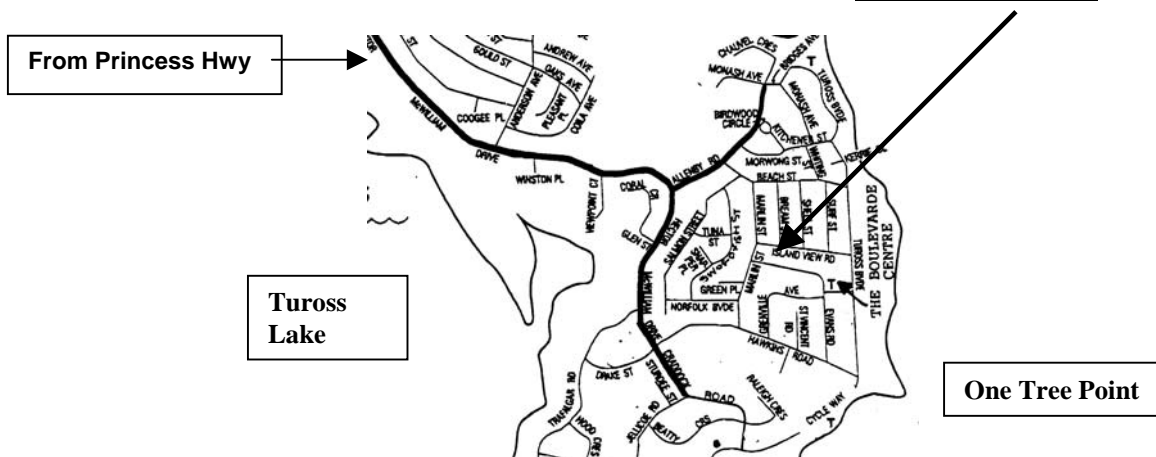

The committee has organised a Fishing Competition at **Tuross Heads**, on the **weekend of the 16th – 18th February 2007**. All members and their friends are invited to this competition. Entrants are encouraged to arrive on Friday night to allow for an early start Saturday morning.

Fishing to **commence on sunrise Saturday** and conclude at 12 Noon Sunday with the official weigh-in. Any fishing conducted outside of this time frame is not recognised as part of the competition. There is a **\$50 entry fee** to the **Fishing Competition**. As this is a social gathering the entrants are encouraged to reside together, the Association is arranging accommodation. An **Accommodation fee of \$50** applies, this covers Friday and Saturday nights at two houses, the main meeting point will be at **9 Island View rd, Tuross Heads NSW**.



Please note that we have quality houses booked and we need confirmed bookings and deposit before the trip, otherwise one of the house bookings will be cancelled.

For your own convenience, bring along a sleeping bag. Light Breakfast - Eggs bacon, coffee, milk bread, cereals and spreads will be supplied.
